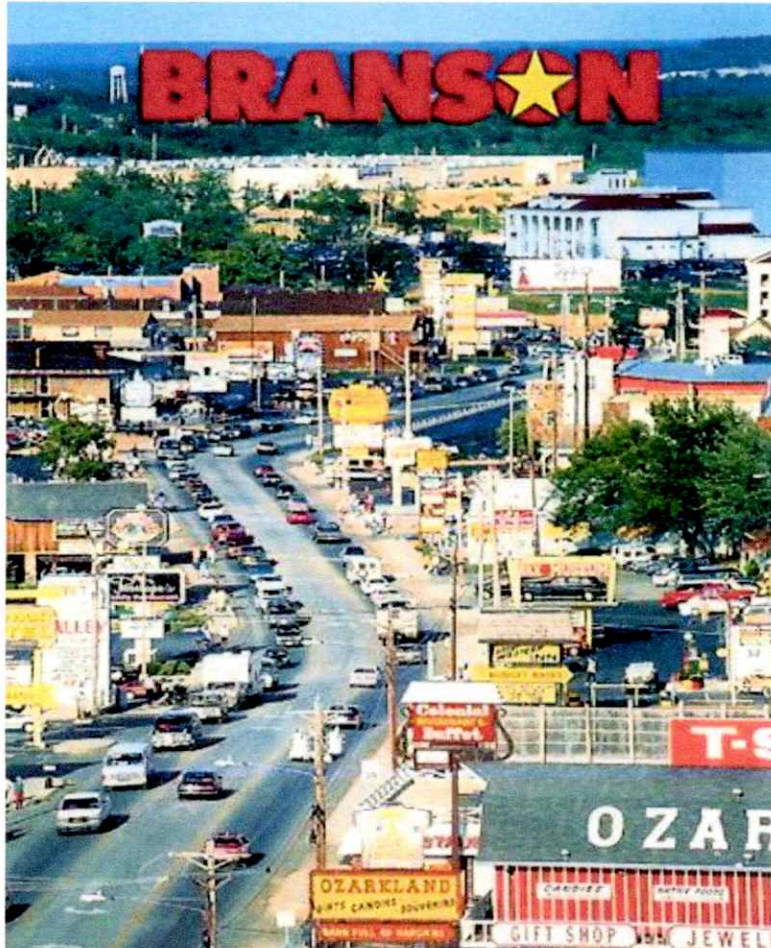

**Day One, Monday, November 30, 2020 (CB, D)**

We'll depart early this morning and have a continental breakfast en route. Lunch is on your own about noon as we continue on toward Springfield, MO and our visit to Fantastic Caverns. It's "America's Tram Ride Through Caves" where you will get an up-close look at beautiful cave formations like giant columns stretching from floor to ceiling, delicate soda straws glistening with minerals and tiny cave pearls hidden in crystal-clear water. Then it's on to Lambert's Café, home of the "throwed rolls" in Ozark for an included dinner before arriving into Branson mid-evening at our centrally located hotel, the Best Western Center Pointe Inn located in the heart of the entertainment district. It offers an indoor pool and features microwaves and refrigerators in all rooms. We'll have a "lite" reception while the bags are being delivered to our rooms. The rest of the evening is free to relax and get ready for our exciting next few days.

**Day Two, Tuesday, December 1, 2020 (B, D)**

Start out the morning with a full, hot breakfast buffet prior to our 2-1/2 hour tour with a local step-on guide. We'll drive down the famous 76 Music Country Blvd., see the Trout hatchery, Tablerock Dam, stop at the Scenic Overlook, visit the College of the Ozarks, Historic Hollister and end up in downtown Branson. You will have some free time to visit the 40 shops offering crafts, souvenirs, clothing, shoes and more and choose from at least 5 cafes for lunch on your own. Be sure to stop in the old-fashioned Dick's 5 & 10. In 1961, Dick Hartley started the 1,500 sq. ft. store with the philosophy that no other store would be as well stocked. Today the second generation operates the 10,000 sq. ft. store with over 250,000 different items. It's a "must see".

This afternoon see our first show, the #1 Hits of the 60's at the Clay Cooper Theatre. This fast-paced show is a blast from the past touching on 100 songs from artists like Elvis Presley, the Beach Boys, The Supremes, Paul Anka, Buddy Holly & more. Add to that 100 costume changes and one talented cast and you get the ultimate decade show!

Following the show you can either go back to the hotel for a little rest or be dropped off at the Ozark Imax Complex across the street. It offers several gift shops with souvenirs, leather goods, jewelry, quilts and more.

Tonight, we'll walk to dinner at Montana Mike's located in our hotel's parking lot where you'll have your choice of sirloin steak, chicken fried sirloin steak, fried catfish strips or fire grilled chicken breast with dinner salad, rolls, dessert, coffee and iced tea.

Our show this evening will be the Hughes Brothers Christmas Show at their theatre. It was awarded Best Christmas show this past December and it will warm your heart as they bring festive surprises, treasured traditions and lots of magic of the season.

### **Day Three, Wednesday, December 2, 2020 (B, L/Cruise, D)**

Enjoy a hot breakfast buffet at leisure before we head out for the day. There will be two options this morning. You can visit the Branson Craft Mall with over 16,000 sq. ft. of arts and crafts from the Ozarks and see the craftsmen while they work. Or, spend a little time with me at the Queen Elizabeth Shop nearby offering unique and contemporary fashion. They carry many “gaudy and glitzy” styles of dresses, skirts and pants for sizes tween through 5x. They also carry jewelry, belts, purses and shoes.

Then we're off to the Showboat Branson Belle for lunch and their musical variety show on their 700-passenger paddle-wheeler as it cruises Table Rock Lake. Enjoy the music of the 60's performed by a troupe of singers and dancers alongside their 4-piece band. The luncheon menu will include Honey Citrus Chicken or Pot Roast and Gravy with green beans, garlic mashed potatoes and Lemon Berry Ice Cream Pie for dessert.

After the show, we'll head back to the hotel for some free time where you'll have an opportunity to visit the Titanic Museum on your own. It's conveniently located next to our hotel.

In late afternoon there will be a brief visit to Branson Landing, located on the shores of Lake Taneycomo with over 45,000 sq. ft. of retail shops and restaurants. Dinner will be here at the Black Oak Grill where you can choose your entrée from Rosemary Grilled Chicken, Ribeye Steak, Grilled Salmon or Baby Back Ribs, all served with New York Cheesecake for dessert.

Tonight, you're in for a real treat when we attend “Six”, and their Christmas Show at the American Bandstand Theatre. You simply won't believe what comes out of these six talented real brothers' mouths—percussion, instruments, and harmonies—with just 6 human voices playing all the best Christmas tunes.

### **Day Four, Thursday, December 3, 2020 (B, D)**

The day begins with the breakfast buffet at your leisure before attending Dublin's Irish Tenors & Celtic Ladies Christmas Show at King's Castle Theatre. Dublin's Irish tenors are five of Ireland's finest singers that perform some of the best Irish classics, opera, pop and swing. The Celtic Ladies bring a mix of contemporary music and classical blend of music and dance to the stage.

You'll enjoy some free time at the Grand Village Shoppes with over 20 unique stores lining the cobblestone streets. They include Missouri's largest Christmas shop, Kringle's, with 125 themed and decorated trees, a wonderful toy store, the Thomas Kincade Art Gallery, leather store, gourmet foods (with samples), home and garden décor store and even a Christian book store with wonderful inspirational gifts.

Lunch will be on your own at one of two tasty restaurants—Mel’s Hard Luck Diner with singing servers or at the Sugar Leaf Bakery & Café offering soups, salads and sandwiches. Note that desserts are their specialty!

Late afternoon finds us at the beautiful Sight & Sound Theatre to attend “Noah” and the story of the “Great Promise”, complete with live animals!

Our dinner is at the lovely Chateau on the Lake Resort in a private dining room where you’ll have a choice of entrees to include Beef Medallions with au/jus, Roasted Pork Loin or Apple Glazed Chicken. Dessert is their infamous Carrot Cake. Before dinner, be sure to partake of a beverage in their beautiful bar, check out their gift shop and gingerbread houses and other areas decked out for Christmas.

Our evening concludes with a lighted LED drive through Christmas venue with over 300 displays before returning to our hotel for the evening.

**Day Five, Friday, December 4, 2020 (B)**

After our last hot breakfast buffet and luggage pick-up, we’ll head toward home with a brief stop in Springfield, Missouri at Bass Pro and continuing on with breaks and lunch on your own along the way. A quick dinner stop will be made near Morton, Illinois, before arriving back in Davenport with lots of great Branson memories!
