Day One: Monday, November 30 (CB,D)

We'll depart early this morning and have a treat enroute. Lunch is on our own, about noon, as we continue toward Branson, MO and our Holiday getaway. A trip to the Ozarks wouldn't be complete if we didn't stop at Redmon's Candy Store. They have fantastic restrooms. Also, every kind of candy you can imagine. As dinnertime draws near, we'll stop at Lambert's Café, home of the "thrown rolls" in Ozark for an included dinner. Mid-evening we'll arrive in Branson to our nicely appointed hotel, complete with a lovely indoor pool and sauna and microwaves & refrigerators in each guest room. After check-in, the balance of the evening is free.

Day Two: Tuesday, December 1 (B,L,D)

We have a hot breakfast at the Best Western Music Capital before we go to the Cassandre – the Voice of An Angel Christmas Spectacular, a 30-year performer in Branson. Lunch is at the Hughes Brothers Family Christmas Show--a triumph of everything you want to feel at Christmas time. The Hughes Brothers transports you to a Christmas wonderland filled with the season's best vocal harmonies, exciting dances and inspiring instrumentals. Lunch will be Hawaiian chicken breast on a bed of wild rice with a side of lightly seasoned green beans. Then it's on to the Branson Craft Mall. It's on to Landry's Seafood House where you'll have your choice of top sirloin, chicken and mushrooms, Tilapia and fried shrimp, all served with a salad bowl, bread, dessert and a soft drink. And then it's on to the Presley's Country Jubilee, the one where it all began. They were an Ozark's family that played the underground stage of the Missouri Hills. It wasn't long after the show opened in a brand-new theatre. They were a smash hit all across the country.

Day Three, Wednesday, December 2 (B,L,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. We go to the Hot Rods and High Heels Show. The talented cast will transport you to a time when poodle skirts and soda shops were all the rage. You'll be impressed by the stunning costumes, fun dance routines, toe-tapping tunes. Lunch is at the SS Dockside Café and Pub where you'll have chicken strips, French dip, pulled pork sandwich, grilled chicken and fried catfish all served with cookies and a non-alcoholic beverage. New Jersey Nights is a spectacular celebration of Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons. From the back street studio in New Jersey where it all began, this vibrant production includes all of The Four Seasons greatest hits, including Sherry, Rag Dolls, Big Girls Don't Cry, and Walk Like a Man and so much more. Next we go to the Grand Village Shopping Center to do a little shopping at the Kris Kringle Shop. It's Missouri's largest Christmas store. It's all about Christmas. Then we go to Mel's Hard Luck Diner, where the staff waits and sings for you where you'll have a burger, Honky Tonk Hot Dog, Hit the Road Jack Grilled Chicken Sandwich, Groovin Grilled Chicken Salad, and Chattahoochee Chicken Fingers, soup and salad. All served with beverage, side and special ice cream dessert. After dinner we see the Duttons. It started as a family band and grew into one of the most beloved Branson live shows of all time. The Duttons have lit up the stage with a blend of harmony, quick wit, and jaw-dropping musicianship that has taken them from Branson to national television and beyond. It's a family sharing what they love most: music, connection and joy. You'll be amazed at the Branson Joy of Lights Display.

Day Four, Thursday, December 3 (B,L,D)

Extended Continental Breakfast at the hotel as usual before we go to the Doug Gabriel Show. It's the ultimate variety show in Branson's most popular morning show. High energy, great production, hilarious comedy, and incredible music. The show features Branson's most awarded Male Vocalist. Doug and his talented cast and of singers and musicians cover many styles of music from Travis Tritt, Keith Urban, Queen, Ricky Skaggs, Lonestar, Van Halen, and Huey Lewis & The News, and Cher, and even a great tribute to the King of Rock & Roll, Elvis Presley. McFarlain's Restaurant featuring homemade Ozark cuisine. Your choice is a loaded baked potato and vegetable beef soup, half turkey sandwich with vegetable beef soup, hot beef sandwich with light beef gravy and mashed potatoes, all served with a slice of pie with water or iced tea. Next, we go to the #1 Hits of the 60's. This touches over 115 songs of the great artists of the 50's, 60's and 70's. Carole King, The Beatles, ABBA, The Carpenter's, The Bee Gees, Paul Anka...the list goes on and on. Add over 100 costume changes, fun videos, a talented cast of 7 and live band. Black Oak Grill including chicken, center-cut sirloin, chicken fried steak, and grilled salmon, all served with a non-alcoholic beverage, and carrot cake for dessert. Next we'll be going to the Legends in Concert, featuring some of your favorite artist like Kenny Chesney, Johnny Cash, Elvis and the Blues Brothers.

Day Five, Friday, December 4 (B,L,D)

Extended Continental Breakfast. Be sure and stop in at Dick's 5 & 10 - Generations of fun since 1961. It's your one-stop shop for Branson's souvenirs. Then we'll see Melody Hart and the All-Star Band. It's high energy toe-tapping country music at its finest and styles of classic country, Texas Swing, 80-90's country all the way up to today's most popular hits. Wayne and Melody entertain with their twin fiddle numbers but when Melody steps up to the mic with her beautiful voice you can expect to hear anything from Classic Country shuffles to her rockin' the party with songs by some of today's favorite country female artists. Lunch is at the Uptown Café where they'll be serving steak burger with homemade chips, pork tenderloin sandwich with homemade chips, soup of the day and salad, soup and grilled cheese, all served with coffee, tea, water and dessert. Clay Cooper's Country Express has you experience the high energy, action and music. It's on to Gettin' Basted, locally owned and operated where you'll have a choice of pulled pork with baked beans and potato salad, smoked chicken with baked beans and potato salad, turkey with baked beans and potato salad, pit ham with baked beans and potato salad, ribs with baked beans and potato salad, all served with dessert, water or tea. The Sight & Sound production of "Miracle of Christmas." It is about travel back in time to Bethlehem as the original Christmas Story unfolds all around you. Journey along side Mary and Joseph, a flock of surprised shepherds, and three wise men – along with their camels! Day Six, Saturday, December 5 (B)
